

Registration of a Limited Partnership Section 8 – The Limited Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 1995

In accordance with the Limited Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 1995, every limited partnership shall be registered and shall continue to be registered in accordance with section 8 of the law.

A person wishing to register a limited partnership must file with the Greffier (c/o Guernsey Registry) the following documents:

The fee specified by the Greffier (see section 26 of the law);

- A declaration signed by any one or more of the general partners of the following:
 - The name of the limited partnership;
 - The nature and principal place of its business;
 - Its registered office;
 - The full name of every general partner and his address;
 - The term for which the partnership is entered into and the date of the commencement of that term

Please note:

Any application to register a limited partnership **must** be made by a General Partner.

It is the responsibility of the General Partner to ensure that they have met all of the requirements of the law **before** an application is submitted.


