

Change in Registered Particulars

Section 10 – The Limited Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 1995

Why do I need to submit a change in registered particulars?

In accordance with Section 10 of The Limited Partnerships (Guernsey) Law, 1995, any changes made to the following:

- the name of the limited partnership;
- the nature and principal place of its business;
- its registered office;
- the full name of every general partner and his address;
- the term for which the partnership is entered into and the date of the commencement of that term.

must be notified in writing to the Greffier (c/o the Guernsey Registry) within 21 days beginning on the date of the change. Where the change is to the partnerships name or registered office, the change will not be effective **until** the Greffier has issued a new certificate of registration.

Please note:

Any changes in registered particulars **must** be made by the General Partner.

It is the responsibility of the General Partner to ensure that they have met all of the requirements of the law **before** an application is submitted.
